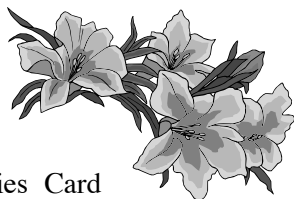

ABBOTT SCOTTISH RITE SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

The following criteria will be used to determine the eligibility of applicants for the program;

- Acceptance at an accredited College or University.
- Children or Grand children of Scottish Rite Masons in NMJ.
- Members of youth organizations sponsored by the Masonic Fraternity in the NMJ.
- Graduates of a Learning Center in the NMJ.
- An applicant must be a graduate of a public or private secondary/preparatory school. *And* entering their Sophomore year of College or University. **Freshman are not eligible.**

Application forms are available through the Office of the Valley Secretary. Completed applications must be returned to the Valley Secretary in duplicate. The deadline for filing is April 1st.

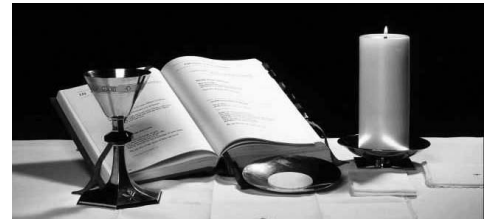
