### "THE ILL. JACK DYE, 33°, & DARWIN A. HOLLIS, MSA CLASS" *March 9 & 10, 2007*



**Ill. Jack Dye, 33°**, was raised a Master Mason in Oakland City Lodge No. 467 on October 19, 1937 and served as Worshipful Master in 1949. He received the degrees of the Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite in the Valley of Evansville in the Spring Class of 1938. Ill. Brother Dye was a member of the York Rite Oakland City Chapter 122, Knight Templar, Princeton, IN #46.

He served these bodies as an officer and served as Grand Master of the Grand Council in 1959. He was created a Sovereign Grand Inspector General, 33°, honorary member of the Supreme Council on September 26, 1979, in Chicago, Illinois.

Ill. Brother Dye, 33°, graduated from Oakland City College in 1938 and received his Master's Degree in Education and Library Science from Indiana State University. He served as librarian and Audio Visual Director for the East Gibson County School Corporation and later owned and operated a restaurant & motel for 33 years. He was active in related bodies of Masonry, Demolay, and Royal Order of Scotland Red Cross of Constantine. He was a member of Good Shepard United Methodist Church and served on the church board.

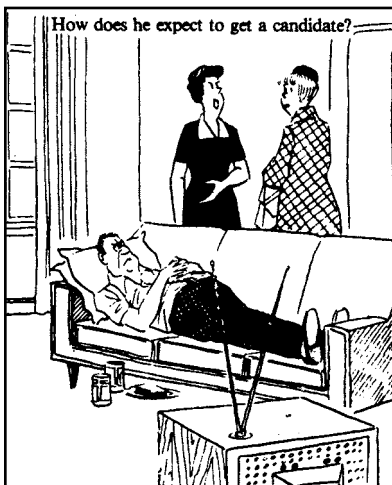
He married Mildred B. Davis on April 25, 1941. Ill. Brother Dye was born on June 15, 1916 and was called from labor on August 3, 1996.



**Brother Darwin A. Hollis, MSA**, was raised a Master Mason in Prince Lodge No. 231 on July 20, 1927, later transferring his membership to Reed Lodge No. 316. He received the Degrees of the Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite in the Valley of Evansville in the Fall Class of 1942.

Brother Hollis was very active in the Valley of Evansville and was rewarded for his efforts by receiving the Meritorious Service Award in the year 1942. He was a farmer, filling station owner, and a pipe fitter. He retired as a Structural Iron Worker.

He was a member of West Side Christian Church and served in many capacities. He married Monace L. Wilson on April 25, 1941. Brother Hollis was born on June 26, 1900 and was called from labor on December 17, 1996
